As part of our 400th Anniversary celebration we have had numerous events throughout the year, commencing with our Opening Ceremony in February. We are extremely proud of our heritage and history beginning with Henry Hudson docking his **Half Moon Ship** in 1609 in what is now known as Haverstraw Bay. The Town of Haverstraw is located on the widest part of the Hudson River and was first named by the Dutch as "**Haverstroo**." Haverstraw was also one of the locations where **General George Washington** set up camp for his troops.
