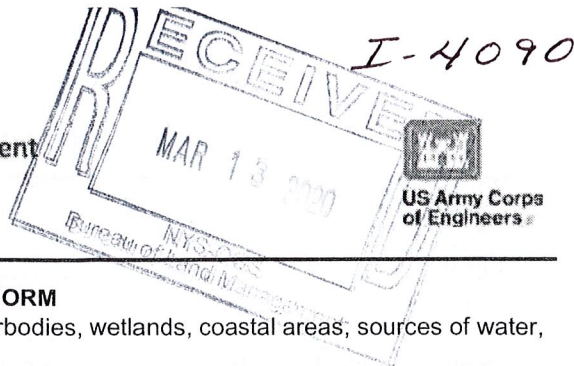

a. Purpose of the proposed project:

Construction of a municipal recreational facility including playing fields, trails, accessory buildings, parking and infrastructure improvements.

b. Description of current site conditions:

The above lots total approximately 25 acres. The parcel has no permanent structures within its boundaries. It is dominated mainly by a disturbed field and a successional hardwood forest with minimal herbaceous and shrub growth beneath the canopy. The wetland areas contain most of the herbaceous and shrub growth. Based on a review of historic aerial photographs and the existing vegetation, the site has had little or no disturbance in the past.

c. Proposed site changes:

The site will be graded to allow construction of the recreational facility, including appropriate cut and fill activities to assure safe working conditions and storm water runoff. Vegetation will be removed. The existing fields will be graded to allow proposed construction. Successional tree growth will be removed. Recreational fields, parking facilities and accessory structures will be constructed.

d. Type of structures and fill materials to be installed, and quantity of materials to be used (e.g., square feet of coverage, cubic yards of fill material, structures below ordinary/mean high water, etc.):

Rock Outlet Protections and stormwater piping will be consist of the following disturbances and materials:  
Approx 3 CY per outfall totaling 9 CY of cut/dredging  
Total disturbance area is approximately 2,995 SF (NWP 7) and 1,345 SF (NWP 42)  
Outlet protection will be constructed of between 4" and 6" d50 clean crushed stone and associated geofabric.

9 CY of material to be removed and placed into the above-ground basin berms

1. Soil erosion and sediment control measures - 2 wk. / 2. Site & tree clearing - 5 wk. / 3. Excavation and earthwork - 4 wk. / 4. Installation of drainage & utilities - 10 wk. / 5. Installation of retaining walls and pedestrian bridges, curbing, parking areas, walkways - 16 wk. / 6. Installation of site features (playground, turf field, splash pad) - 10 wk. / 7. Installation of buildings, site and sports lighting - 4 wk. / 8. Topsoil/seed - 1 wk

Standard silt and soil erosion control measures will be utilized including staked silt fencing and hay bales. No other pollution is expected. Additional plantings throughout the site to offset vegetation loss.

Standard silt and soil erosion control measures will be utilized including staked silt fencing and hay bales.

k. Alternatives considered to avoid regulated areas. If no feasible alternatives exist, explain how the project will minimize impacts:

The project has been reduced in scope to minimize the impact to wetlands. Only those disturbance activities permitted under Nationwide Permits will be conducted and will be within the limits of those permits.

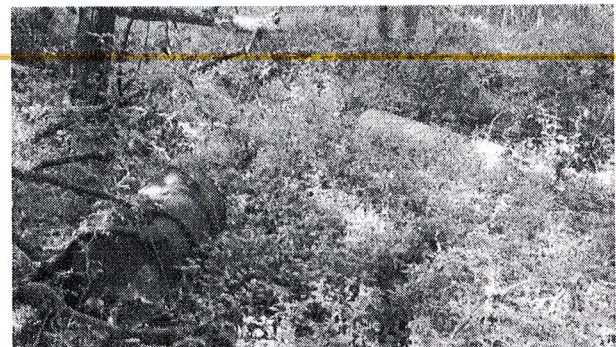

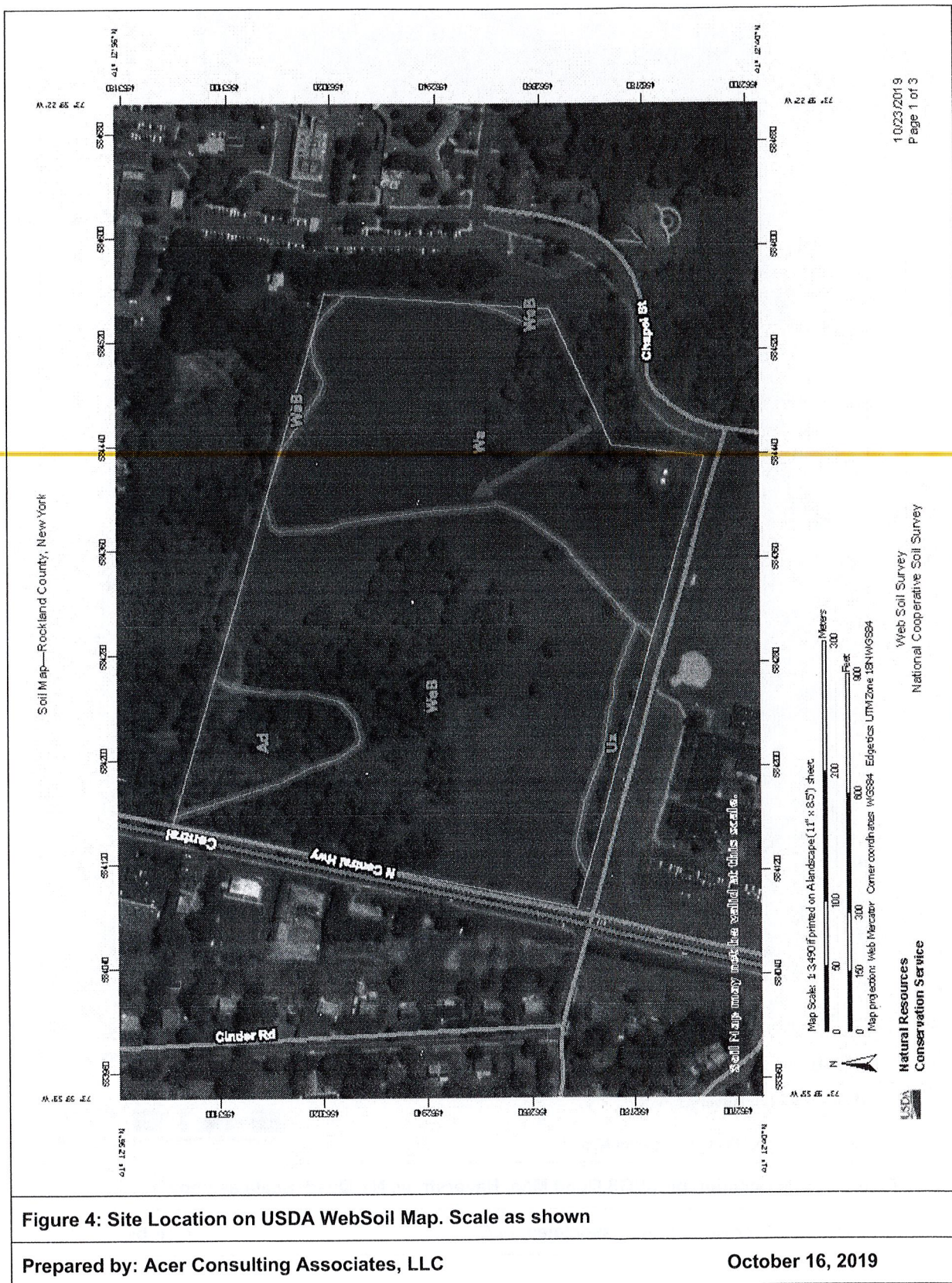


Figure 4: Site Location on USDA WebSoil Map. Scale as shown
